PAPER SUBMISSION: Electronically submit contributed papers not previously published or presented. Each submission must be a 4 to 8 page paper, including an abstract of not more than 150 words. Submission implies that an author will attend 2010 RRM to present the paper. Use of one of the following formats is required: Microsoft Word or LaTeX.
